Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Application to St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant Undergraduate Level for AY 2026-2027

1. Until when can I apply for the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant?

The application period for the **St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant** for AY 2026-2027 is open from **April 17 to May 17, 2026**. There will be no extensions. Results will be released on or before **June 3, 2026**, and will be sent to the email address you provided in the online application portal.

2. Are scholars required to pay the PhP 10,000.00 reservation fee?

Paying the PhP 10,000 reservation fee is at the applicant's discretion. Please note that the fee is non-refundable if the scholarship application is unsuccessful or if the applicant decides not to enroll at DLSU.

Scholars awarded a **100% tuition and fees waiver** are exempted from paying the reservation fee. If the fee was paid before the scholarship results are released, it will be refunded during AY 2026-2027. You will be notified via email regarding the refund process.

For applicants who receive a partial scholarship or no scholarship, the PhP 10,000 reservation fee is neither waived nor refunded. However, it will be credited toward your tuition and fees upon enrollment.

3. When is the schedule of payment of PhP10,000 Reservation Fee?

The reservation fee can be paid online through the University's official payment channels during the following periods:

- First batch: **February 14 to March 14, 2026**

- Second batch: **April 17 to May 17, 2026**

Payment instructions are indicated in the [Frosh Primer](#) (*monitor for updates*).

The Confirmation of Enrollment period is scheduled from **June 9 to July 3, 2026**. Further instructions and updated schedules can be found [here](#).

4. How do I know if I am eligible to apply for the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant?

To be considered for the grant, you must first pass the DLSU College Admissions Test (DCAT). Scholarship results will be released before the Confirmation of Enrollment period.

The University Scholarship Committee selects grantees based on two main criteria:

- **Financial Need:**
 - Family income below ₱450,000: Eligible for full scholarship (100% tuition and fees waiver + stipend)
 - Family income ₱450,000 – ₱1,000,000: Eligible for full scholarship (100% tuition and fees waiver)
 - Family income ₱1,000,001 – ₱1,800,000: Eligible for partial scholarship
- **Academic Competence:** Evaluated based on your high school academic records.

5. What can I do if my family has no digital/printed/official copy of our monthly electric bill and water bill?

If you are unable to submit any required document, please prepare a **Letter of Explanation** addressed to the Director of the Admissions and Scholarships Office.

Clearly state the reason for the non-submission and upload the letter in the corresponding field in the online application portal.

6. How can I apply for the STAR Scholarship? Or other merit scholarships like Vaugirard, Gokongwei or Archer Achievers Scholarship?

DLSU offers two main types of scholarships:

- **Needs-based:** St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant
- **Merit-based:** Awarded to top DCAT performers (including STAR, Vaugirard, Gokongwei, Archer Achievers, Animo Grants, and Laguna 500 scholarships).

Merit-based scholarships are automatically considered for high DCAT scorers and do not require a separate application. The St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant is needs-based and follows a separate application process.

7. If I were awarded the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant, do I need to renew the grant every term?

Yes, the grant is renewable every term. To continue receiving the benefits, you must meet all retention policies and requirements. At the start of each term, the Admissions and Scholarships Office (AdSO) publishes a Helpdesk Announcement with detailed procedures and deadlines for renewal.

8. Can a transferee from another university apply for the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant?

Transferees may apply for the grant after completing at least one term of enrollment at De La Salle University. Announcements for current students (including transferees) are posted via the DLSU Helpdesk Announcement.



9. Can the DOST grant or discount be combined together with the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant?

Yes, the DOST discount may be combined with the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant. To avail of the DOST discount, you must submit a “Letter of Enrollment” (LOE) issued by DOST. This will be processed for crediting at DLSU. For priority courses and other details, please visit the DOST website.

10. How can I apply for athletic scholarships? I am a school athlete in high school.

11. Aside from the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant, what other scholarships or grants can I apply for at DLSU?

12. If I am not awarded a St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant for my first term at DLSU, can I apply on my second term at DLSU?

You may apply after completing one (1) term at DLSU. Current DLSU students (including those not awarded in their first term) may apply for scholarships in subsequent terms. If the application will open, the Admissions and Scholarships Office will announce the application period through a Helpdesk Announcement.

13. Is there a student assistant program at DLSU?

Yes. DLSU offers the **Student Assistantship and Resource Training (START)** program. It is open to both undergraduate and graduate students and provides

not only financial support through a monthly stipend but also valuable work experience and skill development.

14. If I defer my enrollment at DLSU, will the scholarship awarded to me be available when I enroll either on the second or third trimester?

No. The scholarship is valid only for the term in which it is awarded. Scholarships cannot be deferred.
