Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Application to St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant Undergraduate Level for AY 2025-2026

- 1. Until when can I apply for the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant?**The application for the **St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant** for AY 2025-2026 is from **May 10 to June 10, 2025** only. There will be no extension of the application schedule. On **July 07, 2025**, the **application results** will be communicated to applicants through the email address they provided in the online application portal.
- 2. Are scholars required to pay the reservation fee of PhP 10,000.00?**

Applicants who wish to reserve their slot by paying the PhP 10,000.00 reservation fee do so at their own discretion. It's essential to note that this fee is non-refundable in the event that the grant application is unsuccessful or the applicant decides not to enroll.

Scholars who have paid the reservation fee prior to receiving the 100% scholarship award will be eligible for a refund, which will be processed during AY 2025-2026. Notification about the refund will be sent via email.

For students who receive a partial scholarship or are not awarded a scholarship, the PhP 10,000 reservation fee will not be waived or refunded under any circumstances.
- 3. When is the schedule of payment of reservation fee?**

Payment of the reservation fee will be facilitated online through the University's official payment channels, commencing on May 7 and concluding on June 7, 2025.

The Confirmation of Enrollment Period, inclusive of submission of requisite documents, is scheduled as follows: July 8-18, 2025, for the Manila Campus, and July 21, 2025, for the Laguna Campus. 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4. Why can't I access the Online Application Facility for the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant? Every time I click the link, the webpage freezes or doesn't load properly.

If you're experiencing difficulties accessing the site, it's possible due to high traffic volume. To resolve this, try refreshing your browser or attempting to access the site through a different browser or search engine.

Kindly note that only qualified applicants (accepted in 1st, 2nd, 3rd choice and redirected to other programs) are allowed to apply for the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant.

5. What can I do if my family has no digital/printed/official copy of our monthly electric bill?

For any lacking documents/requirements, kindly write a letter of explanation for the non-submission of the specific document/s, addressed to the Director of Office of Admissions and Scholarships, and upload the letter to the respective field in the Google Form.

6. How can I apply for the STAR Scholarship? Or other merit scholarships like Vaugirard, Gokongwei or Archer Achievers Scholarship?

DLSU provides two scholarship types: merit-based awards for academic achievement and needs-based grants for financial assistance.

While the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant is needs-based and available for application at any time, the Archer Achievers scholarships, including its STAR, Vaugirard, and Gokongwei upgrades, are merit-based and awarded to top DCAT scorers prior to their first year of residence in DLSU.

7. Can I apply for the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant if I will take my entrance exam at DLSU during the Special DCAT?

No, only applicants who are accepted in their 1st, 2nd, and 3rd choice, and those redirected to other degree programs are eligible to apply for the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant.



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8. If I were awarded the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant, do I need to renew the grant every term?

Yes, the grant is renewable every term. Recipients must be able to meet all the retention policies of the grant to be able to continuously avail of the benefits of tuition and fees waiver. At the start of each term, the OAS publishes an HDA that provides comprehensive information on the procedures and deadlines for renewing scholarships.

9. Can a transferee from another university apply for the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant?

Transferees are eligible to apply for the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant **after completing a minimum of one term of enrollment** at De La Salle University. For details, emails scholarships@dlsu.edu.ph

10. Can the DOST grant or discount be used together with the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant?

Yes, the DOST discount may be applied simultaneously with the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant. In order to receive the DOST grant discount, grantees are required to submit a "Letter of Enrollment" (LOE) issued by DOST, which will then be processed for crediting at DLSU. 11. Is the PWD discount acceptable? Can it be used together with the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant?

Students with disabilities are eligible for a discount at DLSU. To apply, please present a valid Person With Disability (PWD) ID card and any additional required documents to the Scholarships Desk during the enrollment process.

The PWD discount benefit is applicable solely to tuition fees, with a discount rate of 10%, and may be availed in conjunction with the St. La Salle Financial Assistance Grant.

12. I have not submitted my Recommendation Letter as part of my UG Admission requirements. How can I submit it?

Applications for the Financial Assistance Grant may be submitted by current students at any point during their academic tenure, including the second term, subject to the condition that applications are open and being processed at that time. The Office of Admissions and Scholarships will notify students of these opportunities through a Helpdesk Announcement.
