President's Message



Academic Year 2020-2021 kept our Lasallian community and the rest of the academic sector physically distant, with classes conducted fully online, as the pall cast by the COVID-19 pandemic continued to hover across the globe. For De La Salle University, it underscored a period of introspection and creative strategizing towards a future-proof Lasallian education.

At the annual University General Assembly, we launched our Strategic Plan 2020-2023, which sought to serve as guideposts for every department to navigate this liminal phase, towards achieving our goals.

Amid the shifts and challenges in our educational, social, economic, and psychological landscape, we took on the call to keep the spirit of our community aloft by emphasizing the value of ***communitas***—a shared experience to help us cross the liminal phase of change. This became a key pillar in pursuing the University’s goals.

For our academic goals, I urged the community to consolidate our gains in our learner-centered curriculum and to take advantage of the online mode of teaching and learning. Doing so allowed our faculty and students to become more connected, not only among themselves within their own classes or spheres but also with those from other disciplines. We likewise highlighted the importance of caring for our students, and to extend the same support to our faculty and staff, especially those who were deeply impacted by the pandemic.



Despite the continuing onslaught of the pandemic, De La Salle University as a leading regional HEI remained committed to excellence through its regular assessment and accreditation efforts. In AY 2020-2021, 13 out of its 14 PAASCU-accredited undergraduate programs retained their Level 4 status, which is PAASCU's highest accreditation level. The University also continued to pursue the accreditation of its various graduate programs.

In addition, another program from the Gokongwei College of Engineering was accredited by the Philippine Technological Council-Accreditation and Certification Board for Engineering and Technology (PTC-ACBET), bringing to seven DLSU's engineering programs that are ACBET-certified.



By harnessing its creative energy, being attuned to the shifts in the environment, and maintaining a forward-looking attitude, DLSU launched or revised policies that would further improve the delivery of education. These included creating safe spaces, promoting tolerance and diversity, and establishing a service hub that catered to the increasing needs of the Lasallian community for a streamlined go-to place.

During AY 2020-2021, DLSU's digital transformation under the Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) BITUIN Project continued to be rolled out. The three-year project involves financial management, human resources management, and student life cycle. It means rationalizing and improving access to information, streamlining processes so that they are most efficient to users, and enhancing services for all stakeholders and members of the academic community.




- The project's Core Team started the process using a Design Thinking Approach, an innovation strategy founded on design principles








Key research productivity indicators vis-à-vis HEIs in the region provided DLSU a view of our current standing, pushing us to strengthen our thrust in research. In the country, the University consistently outperformed other private higher education institutions (HEIs) in terms of Scopus-indexed research produced.

DLSU remained the sole Philippine private university in the Times Higher Education (THE) World University Rankings for four consecutive years. THE requires a threshold number of Scopus publications, combined with data on teaching, innovation, international outlook, and reputation. Highlights of DLSU publications included research projects related to battling the COVID-19 pandemic.

PRODUCTION OF SCOPUS PAPERS (COMPARATIVE) AS OF AUGUST 2021




CUMULATIVE SCOPUS INDEXED PUBLICATIONS AS OF OCTOBER 2021

SCOPUS STATISTICS AS OF OCTOBER 2021


