
# RESEARCH



# DLSU SINGLE YEAR OUTPUT




# DLSU CUMULATIVE RESEARCH OUTPUT

# INFRASTRUCTURE

The DLSU Laguna Campus saw continued infrastructure developments during the year. The Santuario de La Salle was consecrated in November 2022. It is the first in the world to be dedicated to the Founder, envisioned as a pilgrimage site for educators. Groundbreaking ceremonies were held for the construction of new buildings.

For its Manila campus, DLSU held the groundbreaking of the St. Mutien Marie Hall in July 2023, a 10-story building which will provide spaces for performances, art and music studios, collaboration areas, and open spaces to help cultivate the creativity and innovation of students. The University also continued the renovation of various teaching laboratories such as Science labs, Engineering labs, and Computer labs.

# ST. MATTHEW GYMNASIUM



- The multi-purpose gym was built on a 3,333 sq.m. lot area and serves as the main structure of the DLSU Integrated School area's Sports Superblock.
- The fully air-conditioned facility can house indoor sports events, such as volleyball, gymnastics, and martial arts, and other functions such as meetings, conferences, and exhibits.


